Why do you think the believers spent time together in the Temple? They could have done this as individuals, why did they do it together?


The Contemporary English Version translates, “they broke bread together in different homes and shared their food happily.” How do you picture this? How does it make you feel when you imagine it?

Acts 2:42-47 New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

⁴²They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

⁴³Awe came upon everyone, because many wonders and signs were being done by the apostles. ⁴⁴All who believed were together and had all things in common; ⁴⁵they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶Day by day, as they spent much time together in the temple, they broke bread at home and ate their food with glad and generous hearts, ⁴⁷praising God and having the goodwill of all the people. And day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.
